

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

## **PATIENT PREPARATION INSTRUCTIONS – ELEVATION THERMOGRAPHY**

Before you arrive for your thermographic examination, certain protocols must be followed to ensure your images reflect

accurate information. Please read the following instructions carefully and adhere to them as closely as possible.

- NO prolonged sun exposure to body areas being imaged FIVE days prior to exam.
- NO use of deodorants, lotions, creams, powders, facial makeup the DAY OF exam.
- NO <u>shaving areas</u> to be imaged **DAY OF** exam.
- NO <u>treatment</u> (chiropractic, acupuncture, TENS, physical therapy, electrical muscle stimulation, ultrasound, hot or cold pack use) or <u>physical stimulation</u> of areas to be imaged **24 HOURS** prior to exam.
- NO exercise 4 HOURS prior to exam.
- If <u>bathing</u>, no closer than **1 HOUR** prior to exam.
- If using <u>pain medications</u>, please avoid taking them for **4 HOURS** prior to exam. **You must consult with** prescribing physician for their consent prior to any change in medication use, such as this.
- Nursing can greatly alter results. For most accurate results, scans should be done 6 months post breast feeding.
- Please **bring a hair tie** with you to the exam.

**Please note:** During the exam you will be disrobed (from waist up for the breast exams, and buttocks exposed for lower body exams) during part of the exam for both imaging and to allow for the surface temperature of the body to equilibrate with the room. A female technician is provided for all our female patients and a male technician for all male patients.

We have enclosed a health history form for you to be filled out before arriving for your exam. If you have copies of any other test results (i.e. mammograms, blood tests, etc.), please bring them with you. If you have any further questions, please contact our office at 972-540-5333.
